INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS 01 | REMOVING THE STOCK INDUCTION HOSE

1. Disconnect the sound generation tube from the sound generation canister.

- 2. Disconnect the induction hose from the airbox.
- 3. Disconnect the PCV tube.
- 4. Disconnect the induction hose from the throttle body.



5. Remove the induction hose from the engine bay.

6. Lift upwards and remove the factory intercooler from the radiator support.

02 | PREPARING THE MISHIMOTO INDUCTION HOSE FOR INSTALLATION

1. Transfer the hose clamps from the stock induction hose to the Mishimoto induction hose.



- 2. Remove the resonator from the stock induction hose.
- 3. Install the resonator onto the Mishimoto induction hose.

4. Attach the supplied cover to the noise generation canister. Reuse the factory clamp from the sound generation tube to secure the cover on the canister.

- 1. Install the Mishimoto induction hose in the engine bay.
- 2. Reconnect the induction hose to the airbox.
- 3. Reconnect the induction hose to the throttle body.



- 4. Reconnect the PCV tube to the induction hose.
